Nicholas has been described as an “ambience producer,” understanding intuitively that designing a space is not only about creating a look, but about how it makes you feel.

Among the featured projects are:

Benedict Canyon Estate, Beverly Hills, a glamorous remodel of an Old Hollywood home, Clint Nicholas Design added soul and sophistication with numerous subtle moves: an edit of outmoded ornamentation, a buttery coating of lime plaster, diffused skylights, and glistening granite and marble surfaces.

Paradise Cove Retreat, Malibu, a modern barn-style campus with spaces carefully knitted together in harmonious synthesis, featuring oak flooring and wire brushed oak walls and ceilings offset with antiques foraged from flea markets by Nicholas, with minimalist moments that highlight art and Malibu's breathtaking ocean vistas.

North Bay Road Residence, Miami Beach, a collaboration with Starwood Hotelier Barry Sternlicht, with inventive pieces, placed within interiors both sumptuous and serene. A home with daring and whimsy rooms through custom lighting and comfort and trust through earthy, textured materials.

Doheny Ranch, Beverly Hills, a major remodel of an expansive ranch-style home with an artful composition of different touches, feels and textures.
