**MARYTA&, a new, international cabinet of design and creativity
launches in Los Angeles during Frieze Week 2026**

LOS ANGELES —**Mary Ta**, the Los Angeles–based design visionary and entrepreneur whose influence has helped shape the landscape of modern design, announced today the launch of **MARYTA&** — a new international cabinet of design, curated gallery and international platform for the exhibition and presentation of design objects, installations, and concepts. Established to encourage collaboration, collecting, discovery, and education, MARYTA& signals a moment of unity, celebrating and sharing the work of multiple cultural and creative forces. The Los Angeles space will reflect Ta’s multi-layered aesthetic; modern, sophisticated and chic; organic, sculptural and monumental; minimal and pure, glamorous and playful.

Its launch during Frieze Week Los Angeles 2026 builds on Ta’s pivotal role in bringing European design excellence to an American audience, and is marked by two landmark presentations: the US premiere installation of **HENRYTIMI los angeles**, and the debut Los Angeles presentation of The HENGE Collectors Lounge designed by **Ugo Cacciatori**.

HENRYTIMI los angeles, an installation of functional artworks, rooted in nature, and made by hand in Italy, will span a gallery space of 8,000 square feet.

During Frieze Week 2026 from February 27 and 28, visitors are invited to meet Henry Timi and view the installation where a daily brunch from 10am–12pm and an evening aperitivo from 4-6pm will be offered.

Simultaneously, MARYTA& will unveil **The HENGE Collectors Lounge**, an immersive, refined and material-driven environment designed by **Ugo Cacciatori** featuring modular seating, cast-metal tables, and a sculptural quartzite bar. From February 25–28, the lounge will offer customers and collectors a moment of respite, connection and a contemplative counterpoint to the energy of Frieze Week, and will remain open on a permanent basis. Ta was the first to bring HENGE to the US market and continues to champion its evolution as a brand that is now recognized worldwide for its distinct use of rare materials, precious finishes, and extraordinary proportions.

Ta is best known for establishing Minotti's US presence and market through its showroom in Los Angeles, and as the founder of and visionary behind MASS Beverly, the influential West Coast showroom that has introduced and championed many of Europe's most important contemporary design brands in the US and provides a rare, full service design resource for complete residential projects.

Her new venture MARYTA& is a new and ambitious global platform for design that aims to spotlight excellence in craftsmanship, material innovation, and artistic expression while engaging and expanding a collaborative network of designers, collectors and creatives around the world. Its dual activation during Frieze Week underscores Ta's commitment to Los Angeles as a global design capital and her passion for cross-cultural creative exchange.
